1. Set up an "Xtreme Cuisine" class in your school or youth setting (ages 10-15 recommended.) Please review curriculum and fill out a Partner Application to order classroom sets at www.Florida-Agriculture.com/xtreme.htm
2. Using existing curriculum, conduct an "Xtreme Cuisine" class (at least 10 students) between September 30, 2009 and December 31, 2009.
3. Students will prepare at least 2 "Xtreme Cuisine" recipes from the "Know your Nutrition Activity Book" (page 16-17) or the "Xtreme Cuisine Kids Cookbook" using at least 6 total fresh Florida fruit and vegetable commodities. Commodity substitutions are allowed. Frozen commodities are acceptable when commodities are not in season. 2. Photos

- Include at least 2 different photos of "Xtreme Cuisine" class recipes being prepared and 2 photos documenting total Florida commodities used.
- If photos of students' faces are used, please submit a Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services' model release form for each photographed student signed by the student's parent or legal guardian. Identify the student by name on the back or bottom of each photo. Model Releases will be provided with curriculum material.

3. Nutrition Quiz

How much did your students learn? Send in copies of a completed nutrition quiz (Know Your Nutrition Activity Book, page 10) for each student with name, age and youth organization at top right hand corner.

This contest is open to all Florida youth workers in public and private settings. Employees of the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and their immediate families are not eligible. Contestants may enter any number of times. Each entry will be evaluated individually. In the event of a tie in any category, a drawing will be held to choose the winning entry.
